GAELIC VOCAL CLASSES

There is no limit on choir size.

Any choir, group, orchestra, team etc. entered by a school must consist of pupils on the register of that school at the time the Festival is held. Classes specifically for schools are intended for schools which provide a general education. 'Perth City Campus' is accepted as a school. Entries are welcome from choirs from two or more smaller schools where it is necessary for them to combine in order to allow them to participate. Where appropriate, primary school pupils may perform with the secondary school with which they are linked.

GAELIC JUNIOR CHORAL CLASSES

In all 'Own Choice' classes, details must be shown on the Entry Form.

A photocopy of the item/s must be submitted in accordance with regulation 20.

Class 077 Gaelic Choral Singing, Primary school age - unison

Own Choice of two contrasting unison songs selected from any An Comunn Gaidhealach publication. Total time not to exceed 6 minutes.

Class 078 Gaelic Choral Singing, Primary school age - harmony

Own Choice of two contrasting 2-part harmony songs selected from any An Comunn Gaidhealach publication. Total time not to exceed 6 minutes.

Class 079 Gaelic Choral Singing, Secondary school age - unison

Own Choice of two contrasting unison songs selected from any An Comunn Gaidhealach publication. Total time not to exceed 6 minutes.

Class 080 Gaelic Choral Singing, Secondary school age - harmony

Own Choice of two contrasting 2-part harmony songs selected from any An Comunn Gaidhealach publication. Total time not to exceed 6 minutes.

Own Choice of one song

VOCAL SOLOS

Class 101 Vocal Solo - Gaelic Songs, Boys or Girls aged under 10

Own choice of one Gaelic song, time limit 2 minutes, to be sung unaccompanied
One copy of the chosen song to be sent to the Music Secretary by 8th February

Class 105 Vocal Solo - Gaelic Songs, Boys or Girls aged 10 or 11

Own choice of one Gaelic song, time limit 2 minutes, to be sung unaccompanied
One copy of the chosen song to be sent to the Music Secretary by 8th February

Class 110 Vocal Solo - Gaelic Songs, Boys or Girls aged 12 or 13

Own choice of one Gaelic song, time limit 2 minutes, to be sung unaccompanied
One copy of the chosen song to be sent to the Music Secretary by 8th February

Class 115 Vocal Solo - Gaelic Songs, Boys or Girls aged 14 or 15

Own choice of one Gaelic song, time limit 3 minutes, to be sung unaccompanied
One copy of the chosen song to be sent to the Music Secretary by 8th February

Class 123 Vocal Solo - Gaelic Songs, Boys or Girls aged 16 or 17

Own choice of one Gaelic song, time limit 3 minutes, to be sung unaccompanied
One copy of the chosen song to be sent to the Music Secretary by 8th February

Class 149 Vocal Solo, Gaelic Songs, aged 18 & over

Own Choice of two contrasting Gaelic Songs, maximum performance time 6 minutes,
to be sung unaccompanied
One copy of the chosen songs to be sent to the Music Secretary by 8th February
