NEW CLASS

Class 042 Drumming on Pad, 10 and under

Two parts of a Quick March, may be accompanied by chanter if desired.

NEW CLASS

Class 043 Drumming on Pad, 11 and over

Two parts of a Quick March, may be accompanied by chanter if desired.

NEW CLASS

Class 044 Novice Snare Drum

Restricted to drummers who, at the time of entry, have never been placed 1st in a solo piping contest. Four parts of a Quick March, to be accompanied by pipes.

NEW CLASS

Class 045 Snare Drum (March)

Minimum 4 parts quick march (in 2/4 time signature), to be accompanied by pipes. 1 x 4-parted, 1 x 6-parted, 2 x 2-parted or 3 x 2-parted marches.

Class 046 Snare Drum (March, Strathspey and Reel)

4 parts each tune, to be accompanied by pipes.

NEW CLASS

Class 047 Novice Tenor Drum

Minimum 4 parts quick march (in 2/4 time signature), to be accompanied by snare drum and up to 2 pipers. 1 x 4-parted, 1 x 6-parted, 2 x 2-parted or 3 x 2-parted marches.

NEW CLASS

Class 048 Tenor Drum (March)

4 parts of quick march (in 2/4 time signature), to be accompanied by snare drum and up to 2 pipers. 1 x 4-parted march or 2 x 2-parted marches

NEW CLASS

Class 049 Tenor Drum (March, Strathspey and Reel)

4 parts each tune, to be accompanied by snare drum and up to 2 pipers.
