388 Prepared Reading, aged 9 or 10

Own Choice of passage from 'Prince Caspian' by C.S. Lewis OR 'Coraline' by Neil Gaiman, not exceeding 2 minutes.

389 Prepared Reading, aged 11 or 12

Own Choice of passage from 'War Horse' by Michael Morpungo OR 'The Railway Children' by E. Nesbitt, not exceeding 2 minutes.

390 Prepared Reading, aged 13 or 14

Own Choice of passage from 'The Book Thief' by Markus Zusak OR 'Jekyll and Hyde' by R.L. Stevenson, not exceeding 2 minutes.

391 Prepared Reading, Open

Own Choice of passage from 'Dune' by Frank Herbert OR 'Jane Eyre' by Charlotte Bronte, not exceeding 4 minutes.
