In all 'Own Choice' classes, details must be shown on the Entry Form.

A photocopy of the item/s must be submitted in accordance with regulation 19.

Please note that, in accordance with regulation 18, photocopies should NOT be attached to the entry form.

- 022 Ceilidh Band, open to all levels**
Own Choice, not to exceed 6 minutes.
Amplification is permitted and performers are reminded that they must provide all their own equipment.
Regulation 27 does not apply in this class.
- 023 Scots Fiddle Solo, Beginners (up to 2 years playing)**
Own Choice of Air or March, not to exceed 2 minutes
If accompanist is required, entrants must provide their own.
- 024 Scots Fiddle Solo, Elementary**
Own Choice of Air or March, not to exceed 2 minutes
If accompanist is required, entrants must provide their own.
- 025 Scots Fiddle Solo, under 16 (unaccompanied)**
Own Choice - Air or March (stating which), Strathspey and Reel.
- 026 Scots Fiddle Solo, aged 16 & over (unaccompanied)**
Award: The Niel Gow Memorial Trophy
Own Choice - Air or March (stating which), Strathspey and Reel.
- 027 Scots Fiddle Solo, aged 16 & over (accompanied)**
Own Choice - Air or March (stating which), Strathspey and Reel.
Entrants must provide their own accompanist.

In classes 028-030, competitors may enter only one class.

- 028 Pianoforte Solo (Elementary) - Scottish Traditional Music**
Own choice of march, not to exceed 2 minutes.
- 029 Pianoforte Solo (Intermediate) - Scottish Traditional Music**
Own Choice - March, Strathspey and Reel, not to exceed 5 minutes.
- 030 Pianoforte Solo (Advanced) - Scottish Traditional Music**
Own Choice - March, Strathspey and Reel, not to exceed 5 minutes.

In classes 031-033, competitors may enter only one class.

- 031 Accordion Solo (Elementary) - Scottish Traditional Music**
Own choice of march, not to exceed 2 minutes.
- 032 Accordion Solo (Intermediate) - Scottish Traditional Music**
Own Choice - March, Strathspey and Reel, not to exceed 5 minutes.
- 033 Accordion Solo (Advanced) - Scottish Traditional Music**
Own Choice - March, Strathspey and Reel, not to exceed 5 minutes.

**In classes 034-039, competitors may enter only one class.
No marks will be allocated, but 1st, 2nd & 3rd places will be announced by the adjudicator.
All tunes to be played from memory.**

Competitors failing to be ready to perform when called will forfeit their right to perform; see regulation 28.

034 Practice Chanter, under 13

Award: The Perth and District Pipe Band Trophy is awarded to the winner.
Two parts of a Quick March (own time signature).

035 Practice Chanter, 13 - 16

Two parts Slow Air and two parts Quick March.

036 Novice Bagpipes, under 13

Restricted to pipers who, at the time of entry, have never been placed 1st in a solo piping contest
Four parts Quick March.

037 Novice Bagpipes, 13 - 18

Restricted to pipers who, at the time of entry, have never been placed 1st in a solo piping contest.
Four parts Quick March.

038 Bagpipes - March, Strathspey & Reel, under 13

Minimum requirement: One four parted 2/4 Quick March, four part Strathspey and four part Reel.

039 Bagpipes - March, Strathspey & Reel, 13 - 18

Minimum requirement: March, Strathspey and Reel each with a minimum four parts.

**In classes 040-043, competitors may enter only one class.
No marks will be allocated, but 1st, 2nd & 3rd places will be announced by the adjudicator.
All parts to be played from memory.**

Where required, performers should supply their own piper.

040 Stick and Pad, under 13

Two parts of a Quick March, may be accompanied by chanter if desired.

041 Stick and Pad, 13 - 16

Four parts of a Quick March, may be accompanied by chanter if desired.

042 Novice solo snare drum, under 13

Four parts of a Quick March, to be accompanied by pipes.

043 Novice solo snare drum, 13 - 18

Four parts of a Quick March, to be accompanied by pipes.
